On 30 May 2017, members of the Board of Trustees of the Foundation for the International Prevention of Genocide and Mass Atrocities held their annual meeting at the Central European University. At the event, Mr. György Tatár, Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Foundation, Mr. Enzo Maria Le Fevre Cervini, Vice-Chair of the Board of Trustees (on skype), Mrs. Erzsébet Kaponyi, Mr. Hasan Nuhanovic (on skype), Mr. István Lakatos, Mr. Prem Kumar Rajaram, and Mr. József Zsengeller, the Members of the Board of Trustees of the Foundation and Mr. Zsolt Enyedi, Vice-President of the CEU were present.

The Board of Trustees has discussed the activities of the Foundation in 2016-2017 and set objectives for the activities in 2017-2018.

Main points of the meeting

- Developing cooperation with educational institutions (universities, high schools and primary schools as well), organizations working with vulnerable groups, churches and governmental institutions including ministries and embassies would further strengthen the genocide prevention community.
- New tools and technologies should be better incorporated into the activities of the Foundation.
- Using social media and other modern communication technologies are useful tools for reaching out to the broader society and complementing the awareness-raising efforts of the workshops and publications of the Foundation.
- More emphasis should be placed on the education, as well as the issue of migration and its relation to genocide.

- Potential topics for educational activities should include discrimination, human rights, hate crime and hate speech, genocide and the situation and education of Roma community in Hungary. The Roma Education Fund that is present in both Hungary and the Balkans and the Roma College of the Karoli Gaspar University were regarded as potential partners.
- Empowering younger generations by providing them with tool kit on how to effectively organize discussions on the aforementioned topics could multiply the impact of the Foundation's activities in this field.
- Strong strategic vision and securing financial stability are both needed for ensuring long-term continuity of the Foundation's activities.
