**“WORDS ARE STONES”** is a project co-funded by the European Union’s Rights, Equality and Citizenship Programme (2014-2020), with 10 partners from 8 EU countries working together to address situations of online hate speech. They cooperate with IT companies and the media to combat illegal hate speech and promote counter-narratives proposed by civil society actors.

The project aims to combat racism and discrimination in their online expression of hate speech by equipping young social media managers, influencers, online activists and young people in general with the competences necessary to recognize and act against such human rights violations.

## EU wide project actions:

- A train the trainers course for young social media strategists, community managers, influencers, bloggers and online activists.
- Training for young influencers in 8 countries: Italy, Spain, Czech Republic, Romania, Hungary, Greece, Bulgaria and Lithuania.
- A youth media campaign with on and offline activities, to **“Stop #hatespeech, let’s create a #hatersfree world.”**
- A contest and award to combat hate speech online, where participants will present and vote the best cases of preventing or counter-acting hate speech, and the best conduct of online users for a more inclusive Internet. **#ijoin the #hatersfree contest!**
