Participants of dialogue listen to and hear each other. This is the prerequisite for developing a common perspective which could be shared by wide range of citizens.

Building up and sustaining the culture and practice of dialogue - and thus preventing the division of society - is an eternal interest of the Hungarian nation.

To this end:

- the institution of dialogue should be enshrined in law/constitution;
- "dialogue points" should be established;
- development of dialogue skills should be made an integral part of education.

The "Dialogue Tree" will be piece of the legacy of the participants in the Round Table of the Opposition in 1989 for all Hungarians who stand up for the elimination of enmity, for the public discourse free of hatred and stigmatization, for human dignity, mutual respect and settlement of conflicts through involvement of all concerned parties.
